As a landlocked country, many of Uganda's population rely on subsistence agriculture to feed their families. However, the agriculture sector continues to be hindered from its full potential due to poor agricultural practices, insecurity over land ownership, severe climate and environmental conditions and lack of education for farmers, meaning the vast majority of farmers across Uganda and South Sudan are unable to feed their family enough.

CASE STUDY

Behind this gentleman's beaming smile is an incredible story of transformation. After living in BidiBidi most of his life, this gentleman expressed his trials of living in camp, and the ongoing struggle of being able to produce consistent healthy crops for his family.

After attending HHA's agricultural workshops and being taught the best practices of farming, he has had a very successful harvest. After selling cabbages and onions from his field, he raised enough money to buy a sheep to help him with additional farming and provide milk to improve his diet.
